AROUND TU - IT AWARDS PROGRAM

The new AROUND TU - IT awards program has been developed to encourage, motivate, create excitement and involve more men through their local churches. It is a program that encourages men to get "around tu -it " for Jesus Christ, a program that will recognize and reward each man's efforts. Please return the registration form each time you complete a new level in the program.

- Level I Bronze coin:** To receive the first coin in the awards program, a total of 30 points is required.
- Level II Silver coin:** To receive the silver coin, a man must first have received the bronze coin and then accumulate an additional 50 points.
- Level III Gold coin:** To receive the gold coin, a man must have received both the bronze and silver coins and then accumulate an additional 20 points.

Points are accumulated by participating in the following church or service oriented activities:

Level I Bronze coin 30 point required

Points

- 15 Attend the July 21-25, **2007** General Assembly at Fort Worth, TX
- 15 Attend either the September **2006/2007** Bedford or Barbee Men's Retreat
- 15 Attend the November 10-12, **2006** Indiana Regional Assembly at Indianapolis
- 5 Volunteer efforts in a community organization that serves others
- 5 Daily devotional reading
- 5 Mentor a young person
- 3 Attend a church musical program
- 3 Attend a special church educational program
- 3 Participate regularly in church choir
- 3 Regularly attend the local Men's Fellowship group
- 3 Participate in a church Bible study for program year
- 3 Sacrifice for the Lenten season
- 3/month Attend church regularly at least twice each month (3points/month with 15 points max)

Level II Silver coin 50 points required

Points

- 5 Serve as an elected officer or committee chair of a local congregation
- 5 Participate in a church or region mission project
- 5 Serve as an officer of a local Men's group
- 5 Teach a Sunday School Class
- 5 Bring a guest to one of the Men's Retreats
- 5 Bring another person/family to church

- 5 Serve as counselor or director at summer camp and conference for children and youth
- 5 Develop a local church program
- 5 Develop an Indiana Men's Program
- 5 Participate as a volunteer helper during Church camping season
- 5 Participate in a "Congregational Equipping Event" (similar to the old CLEAR Day program)
- 5 Attend a spiritual enrichment event (i.e. "Walk to Emmaus", "Great Banquet", etc.)
- 5 Increase your financial pledge to the church by 1% of income
- 3 Participate in a men's breakfast, luncheon or dinner program
- 3 Participate in a workday program at Camp Bedford or Barbee
- 3 Sponsor a Children's / Youth meeting or event
- 3 Lead Children / Youth programming
- 3 Assist with leadership at Regional Pastor's Class retreats
- 3 Attend a church musical program (additional to Level I)
- 3 Attend a special church educational program (additional to Level I)
- 3 Participate regularly in church choir (additional to Level I)
- 3 Participate in a church Bible study for program year (additional to Level I)
- 3 Participate on a church committee or project
- 3 Regularly attend the local Men's Fellowship group (additional to Level I)
- 3/month Attend Church regularly at least twice/month (3 points/month with 9 points max)
- 3/month Attend Sunday School at least twice/month (3 points/month with 9 points max)

Level III Gold coin 20 points required

Points

- 10 Serve as a member of the Commission on Men's Ministries
- 10 Serve as a member of any Commission of the Christian Church in Indiana
- 10 Serve as an officer of any organization of the Christian Church in Indiana
- 10 Serve on the Board of a spiritual enrichment event (i.e. "Walk to Emmaus", "Great Banquet", etc.)
- 10 Give a tithe of your income to the church
- 5 Attend an Indiana Area Church meeting
- 5 Attend / represent the Commission on Men's Ministries at another church
- 5 Bring another person / family to church (additional to Level II)
- 5 Participate on a church committee or project (additional to Level II)
- 5 Do a home repair for an elderly person (2 hours minimum)
- 5 Visit a nursing home resident or visit a home bound person (3 people minimum)

Special Award and the Certificate of Completion

Every man completing all three (3) levels of the AROUND TU-IT Awards program will receive a free registration to either the 2006 / 2007 Bedford or Barbee Men's Retreats. Remember, all men are now eligible to receive a Certificate of Completion/Registration Form to enter the final phase for the Part II Around TU-IT Awards Program.
