9	Attend a national Disciples of Christ event for church	
10	Fill pulpit for minister

12	Encourage starting a new ministry program for your church	
13	Participate in the planning or programming of an ecumenical community event	
14	Mentor an "At Risk" teenager or younger youth (i.e. reading, teaching computer programs after school, Big Brother program, etc.)	
15	Provide parental involvement to your family above and beyond what is considered average	
16	Attend a spiritual enrichment event (i.e. "Walk to Emmaus", "Great Banquet", etc. [additional to Level II])
